

Closure Update – New Information

As the Coronavirus situation unfolds and more information becomes available, the Library will continue to make adjustments in our response. The Library will remain closed to the public until further notice. All library programming is cancelled until further notice. For the present, Staff will be working to offer a reduced level of service. Patrons can still search the [library's online catalog](#) and request materials by phone, email or by placing reserves through the online catalog. Calling us directly at 603-569-2428 will result in the quickest response. Staff will take requests for materials and place them on a book truck outside the front entrance for patron pickup. **This service is available between 10 am and 4 pm Monday through Friday.** Please limit the number of items per request to 10 items. Please hold on to any returns until the Library reopens. All due dates will be extended, and fines waived during the current crisis.

Other online resources available through the library website at wolfeborolibrary.org include language learning software, genealogy databases and legal forms.
